This document has been produced by the Director and Registered Manager of **Sparks Fostering**, Tay Jiva MBE. Tay Jiva was rated an '**Outstanding**' leader by Ofsted in September 2024 and has an **MBE** for the recruitment of Muslim foster carers.

The fostering agency **recruits, assesses, and trains foster carers**. Foster carers provide 'temporary' care for children who are unable to live with their birth family or with family friends: 'Temporary' could mean one night or it could mean several years. Sparks Fostering supports carers with **supervision, training**, and allowances/fees of **between £500 and £1000 a week** (per child). To apply to foster, visit **SparksFostering.org/Quiz**. Sparks Fostering gives **£2,000 referral fee** after 3 months of fostering - to refer a potential carer, email the contact information to **info@sparksfostering.org**.

Other projects run by Sparks Fostering for the Muslim community include:

- Sparks Fostering has been sending gifts to Muslim children in care for the past 3 years. This year, the agency has commissioned a **bespoke gift** to help the children to build resilience, relationships and character. The '**Quran Reflections**' card set has 52 verses from the Quran and **guided reflections** for each verse. The pack can be donated from **QuranReflections.org** from 21 March 2025 and can be used by adults or children.
- Anyone interested in Islamic or career/professional **mentoring** Muslim children in care can submit their details on **sparksfostering.org/Muslim** (mentoring tab).
- Sparks Fostering also provides **training and resources** to other fostering providers about how to support Muslim children in care.
- Sparks Fostering invites mosques and the general public to join a **national fostering campaign** that would place Muslims at the forefront of fostering. See **SparksFostering.org/Muslims** (ambassadors tab) for details.

HRF was first registered with the Charity Commission in 1995 (1043676), then became a company limited by guarantee in 2007.
