Our mentoring program connects children in care with professionals from a wide range of careers, giving them the opportunity to explore future pathways, build confidence and be inspired by positive role models through virtual mentoring.

Whether your experience is in engineering, architecture, healthcare, law, technology, business, education or another profession, your knowledge and encouragement can help shape a child's future.

Mentoring sessions are delivered online and typically last around two hours.
